MATHIEU-DUGUAY // EARLY MUSIC COMPETITION

The **Lamèque International Baroque Music Festival** is proud to launch the Mathieu-Duguay Early Music Competition, seeking to foster and nurture new Canadian talents in early music. This competition is open to any Canadian candidate studying a given instrument in a school of music in Canada or abroad, and who is between 16 and 26 years old on July 1st 2010.

Each candidate wishing to register for the competition should send the following to the Festival office by **January 31st 2010**:

- 1 // A résumé of his musical activities.
- 2 // A proof of age.
- 3 // A CD recording of three different types of musical works from the baroque era (1600 to 1760), played by the candidate.
- 4 // Details of the work the candidate would perform with the Festival orchestra should he be selected as a finalist.

Following receipt of all recordings, a jury of three individuals from the Canadian early music scene will select three finalists who will be invited to perform with the Festival orchestra during the concert scheduled for July 31st, 2010, in Lamèque. Transportation and accommodation will be taken care of by the Festival.

Immediately following the final round, the three-person jury will award three prizes:

1st price / **\$1500** + invitation to perform in the 2011 edition of the Festival. | 2nd price / **\$1000**
3rd price / **\$500** | public's choice / **\$500**

The registration kit should be mailed to the Festival office by no later than January 31st, 2010 (with the date stamp as proof). The Festival reserves the right to reject any application otherwise.
